The State has deemed construction to be an essential business, so permitting and inspections will continue but with some changes. In response to the outbreak, Brian Wert Inspection Agency, Inc. is implementing the following permit and inspection procedures for the safety of our staff and the general public:

Permit Applications

Permits may be applied for online through our website or via email. There is also a drop box next to our office door or applications may be mailed. We will not be accepting applications in person until further notice in an effort to limit person-to-person contact.

Permits may be paid for either by mailing the check or leaving it in the drop box. Please indicate whether we should mail or email the permit back to you. We will not be accepting checks in person until further notice in an effort to limit person-to-person contact.

Inspections

All new commercial and all new residential inspections will be conducted per normal protocol.

We will inspect exterior work per normal protocol, such as for pools, decks, fences, sheds, etc.

We will not be performing inspections within occupied homes (i.e. alterations, additions, repairs, etc.). Inspections will be done on a case-by-case basis via photos, FaceTime, Skype, or other means of technology at the discretion of the inspectors.
